

## Making Princetown an Even Better Place to Live

Princetown Partners brings together local residents and those who deliver services in Princetown to tackle local issues and to make Princetown an even better place to live. Following local consultations the Partners are tackling issues under 3 broad headings: Access & Isolation; Image and Economy.



Princetown Partners have achieved a number of successes over the last year. These include the Fare car scheme, funded by Devon County Council, which provides a low cost taxi service between Princetown, Yelverton and Tavistock. The Partners secured an outreach service by Jobcentre Plus for local people to access advice and support with respect to

benefits, employment and training. In response to local residents concerns, Princetown Partners secured additional police presence in the village during last Summer. West Devon Borough Council, as a member of Princetown Partners, is now holding regular outreach surgeries in the community, providing advice and information about their services, as well as benefits advice.

The Partners are currently finalising their Action Plan for the coming 12 months and welcome comments and contributions from all local residents. For further information contact Jenny at HMCA.
